Rangkuman mengenai Pengalaman Profesional		

Guangjian Tu saat ini adalah Profesor Penuh Hukum di Fakultas Hukum Universitas Makau, anggota seumur hidup Clare Hall (Universitas Cambridge), anggota asosiasi terpilih di Akademi Internasional Hukum Perbandingan dan Anggota Tetap Masyarakat Hukum Internasional Swasta Tiongkok. Beliau adalah seorang editor untuk Chinese Journal of International Law dan blog global www.conflictoflaws.net dan secara teratur diundang untuk mengulas makalah-makalah di jurnal-jurnal internasional. Beliau menerima gelar pertama B.Sc. dari Science and Technology University of Central China (Wuhan, RRC), memperoleh gelar diploma di bidang hukum dari Zhejiang University (Hangzhou, RRC) dan memenuhi syarat untuk menjadi pengacara dan hakim dengan mengikuti ujian nasional RRC. Setelah bertugas di Pengadilan Menengah Ningbo (Provinsi Zhejiang, RRT) selama beberapa waktu, beliau berangkat ke Inggris untuk mengejar gelar LLM dan PhD di Universitas Aberdeen. Beliau secara resmi memulai karir akademisnya di Universitas Makau pada bulan September 2007. Sejak saat itu, ia telah mengajar dan meneliti di bidang Hukum Internasional Swasta, perbandingan hukum swasta. Dia memiliki pengetahuan yang sangat baik tentang Hukum Internasional Swasta Amerika dan Hukum Internasional Swasta Eropa. Beliau sangat terkenal dalam bidang konflik hukum antar wilayah Tiongkok. Beliau adalah Ketua Komisi Khusus untuk Studi Konflik Hukum Antar Daerah di Tiongkok. Sejauh ini, ia telah menerbitkan tiga monograf dan banyak artikel akademis dalam jurnal yang beredar luas dan diakui secara internasional. Beliau telah diundang untuk memberikan presentasi atau pidato publik di banyak kesempatan di tingkat internasional atau tingkat antar daerah.
