<u>Asset preservation endeavour before Lianyungang Intermediate People's Court</u>		
On 27 November 2019, pursuant to the MAA, the Lianyungang Intermediate People's Court in Jiangsu		
Province, China (ie, a mainland court) assisted the HKIAC in an arbitration which had been referred to it by the HKIAC. The arbitration successfully completed a cross-border asset preservation valued at more than \$20 million in Lianyungang city. This is the first case in China where the HKIAC -having delivered papers directly to a mainland court under the auspices of the MAA -has successfully completed an asset.
